About the Jef Schils Memorial Road Race

We have been running the InterBike RR for years. Last year, the date fell on Jef's birthday so we renamed it 'The Jef Schils Memorial Race'. Along with making the race exciting for the riders, our aim was also to bring the non cycling community in to support the race as well. We had a beer tent with music and full commentary at the finish area, Go ride racing, a bouncy castle and BBQ for everyone to enjoy. Despite the weather, it was very successful. This year, we wanted to make the race bigger and have been granted British Cycling National A status.

About Jef Schils 4/09/1931-7/3/2007

As a cyclist he quickly made an impact. As a youth, he won 87 races. In the Independent category he won 18 of the 19 races in which he started - the only one he didn't win being the Belgian Championship where he broke his frame. He became National Professional Belgium Champion in 1952. As a 20 year old, one day before he had to start his 2 year Military Service, despite his limited training opportunities because of his military service, in 1953 he won the 293km long Paris-Tours with a record average of 43.53 km per hour. Despite the many set backs in his career he won 108 Professional road cycling races amongst them many semi-classics. His nickname was "Little Coppi", because the great Fausto who regarded him to be one of his best friends. Eddy Merckx claimed that because his father was a great supporter and took him to watch Jef race it stimulated his desire to start racing. Jef's son Patrick Schils was also Belgian Professional and moved to England in 1983 where he met his wife Nickie and started the Velo Schils InterBike Cycle store (a family run shop in Marks Tey, Colchester).


Notes for all riders

- 4. Do not ride close to the nearside edge of the road because the surface has broken away in places.
- 5. Beware of wildfowl when crossing the reservoir.
- 6. No unauthorised following cars will be tolerated.
- 7. First Aid Service will be provided. Any riders needing hospital treatment will be taken to Colchester General Hospital, Turner Road, Colchester (Tel: 01206 747474).
- 8. A Neutral Race Service Car will be provided. Please bring spare wheels for use by this vehicle.
- 9. Any riders climbing off of their own free will shall be deemed to have abandoned and will not be eligible for any awards.
- 10. Please obey all Race Marshals instructions where given.
- 11. Prize presentation will be at the Marks Tey Hotel, however there will be a podium at the finish straight after the race for the top 3.
